Member Declaration

In order to become a non-clinical affiliate member of UKCP, an individual needs to satisfy the following conditions:

- You have an interest in psychotherapy or psychotherapeutic counselling and wish to support UKCP; and
- You confirm that you are not currently engaged in clinical practice within psychotherapy or psychotherapeutic counselling.
- You have paid the annual subscription fee.

In addition, UKCP non-clinical affiliate members

- cannot claim to be a registered member of UKCP or imply any kind of accreditation by UKCP
- must inform UKCP of any information that is relevant to the individual's terms of non-clinical membership
- are not entitled to vote at any UKCP elections.

UKCP will not have regulatory responsibilities for its individual non-clinical affiliate members

Data protection

Information submitted may be stored and processed electronically for the purposes of delivering services, marketing, supplying information and to enable statistical analysis. Data may be passed to other parts of the organisation, partner organisations, companies or contractors operating on our behalf to enable this to take place.
