Gregor will be speaking about his understanding of the concept of Projective Identification. He will briefly outline Melanie Klein's original ideas and then will choose a number of post Kleinian analysts to show how the concept has been developed and utilised in furthering the understanding of clinical work. Gregor also will also describe how the concept has helped him in his own clinical work.

About the Speaker

Gregor is a Psychoanalyst (BPAC) and Adult and Child Psychotherapist (UKCP) working in full time private practice near Alexandra Park north London. Prior to this he was clinical lead for many years in an East London Child and Adolescent Service (CAMHS). He has also had past experience working in the voluntary sector including leading a team in a residential therapeutic community for young people with addictions.
